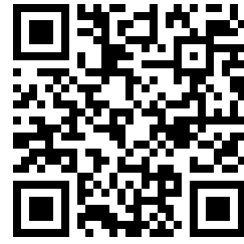

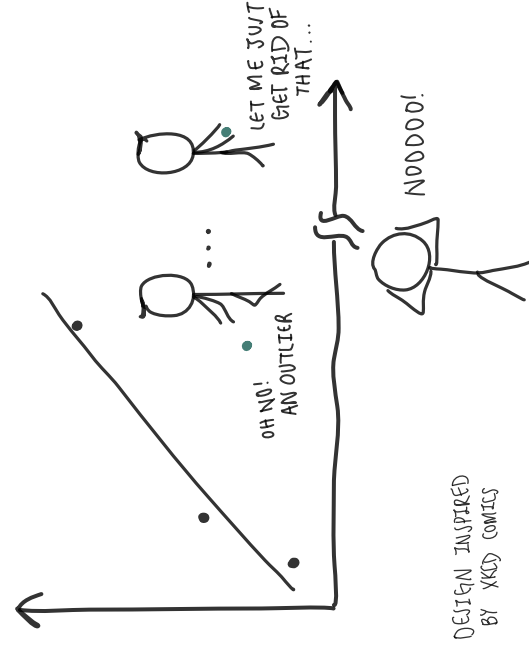
WHAT do we report

Data Fabrication

This applies to any “research planned, conducted, or reported at Stanford or elsewhere by Stanford affiliated individuals”

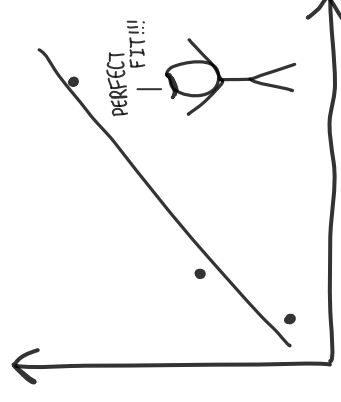


Information on the forms of research misconduct and how to avoid them



What we do not report

Honest mistakes or differences in interpretation or judgement



WHO YOU GONNA CALL?!

HOW do we report

1 Submit a concern to the appropriate figure

This will open up an inquiry
There is no jeopardization of employment for reporting

in 60 days

2 The accused individual will be informed of allegation and invited to comment. This will help determine if an investigation is necessary

in 90 days

3 An investigation is conducted

4 The investigation may lead to appropriate disciplinary action

Federal funding agencies also have the right to impose additional sanctions

Confidentiality statement

“best efforts shall be made (where feasible) to protect the confidence of the complainant(s)”
